Application for Academic Scholarship

Requirements:

- 1) Scholarship candidates must have a home address/be a resident of Flagler, St. John's or Volusia County.
- 2) Candidate must be an IASC Regular Member/Associate Member's child, grandchild or great grandchild and be of Italian descent.
 - 2a) For Associate Members – These members are assumed to not be Italian. They have a child who is also not Italian. That child marries a person of Italian descent. That person becomes eligible to apply for the scholarships. Their children become eligible to apply for the scholarships.
- 3) Candidate must be accepted by or are enrolled in an accredited college or university or planning to attend graduate school.
- 4) Candidate must write and submit a minimum 500 word essay as detailed later in the application.
- 5) All qualified candidates will be interviewed by the Scholarship Committee prior to award selection.
- 6) Scholarship candidates must have a 3.0 or better GPA, based on a scale of 1 to 4. A 3.5 or better GPA is required if the scale is based on 1 to 5.
- 7) A sponsoring member must be a member of the IASC in good standing and have been a member of the IASC for at least 1 year prior to the application submittal date. A sponsoring member will also be considered to be in good standing for the scholarship application process if the sponsoring member has joined the IASC mid-year and then pays their next year's dues by the scholarship application submittal deadline. Usually mid-January of the following year.
- 8) Students who meet the above requirements and are "home schooled" are eligible to apply.

Your essay needs to be about the progression of your academic career to date and how this scholarship will help support that effort. Word length up to student.
